#### Has your Block Parent sign expired?

If your Block Parent sign does not have a "14", "15" or "16" sticker on the front, you are NOT up to date. In order to legitimize our program and minimize risks, all Block Parent signs must have an up to date sticker. To get an updated sticker, all Block Parents need to update their Police Records Checks

The Waterloo Regional Block Parent Program Board of Directors Participated in a 6 hour strategic planning session earlier this year.



One of the outcomes of the strategic planning session is to focus on fostering partnerships with fellow community organizations such as Crime Stoppers, Neighbourhood Watch and the Waterloo Region Crime Prevention Council

(PRC's). Police Records Checks are a vital component to the program, and they are FREE! Given the importance of this mandate, the Block Parent Program will be calling all Block Parents who have expired signs and PRC's, to arrange pick up of your expired sign. You may be in the midst of getting your updated PRC's, but as per our program policy, we will need to collect your Block Parent sign in the interim. We encourage you to update your PRC's asap and mail them to our office. Once your up to date PRC's are received and reviewed, we will be happy to return the sign to you with a brand new expiry date sticker. Let's work together to ensure that all Block Parent homes are SAFE HOMES!

# Strategic Planning and Internal Audits
